

College Application Checklist for Seniors

Naviance: <http://connection.naviance.com/pwhs>

- ✓ Move your colleges from “Colleges I’m thinking about” to “Colleges I’m applying to”.
- ✓ Change status of Common Application under “Colleges I’m applying to” from “unknown” to “yes” or “no”, depending on if you will be using the Common Application.
- ✓ If using the Common Application, change the email address to the email address you are using for the Common Application (“About Me” under profile).
- ✓ Match your Common Application account to Naviance. Be sure to sign the FERPA agreement first in the Common Application.
- ✓ Add teachers (and also your counselor) who are writing recommendations for you to Naviance. Never invite a teacher recommendation via the Common Application!

Transcript Request:

- ✓ Complete Transcript Request Forms for each college. Forms are available in the College Counseling Office.
- ✓ Submit Transcript Request Forms to the College Counseling Office **at least 12 days prior to due date. All of the above steps must be completed before submitting your TRF’s to the College Counseling Office.**
- ✓ **Dec 4 is the deadline date to submit your TRF’s if you have a application deadline date of Jan 1.**
- ✓ If your college/university requires a counselor recommendation, your Student Profile and Parent Brag sheets must be on file prior to submitting a Transcript Request Form to the College Counseling Office. **IF YOU ARE APPLYING VIA THE COMMON APPLICATION, YOUR COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY AUTOMATICALLY REQUIRES A SCHOOL REPORT/COUNSELOR RECOMMENDATION. YOUR BRAG SHEETS MUST BE ON FILE!**

Sending SAT and ACT scores:

- ✓ Send SAT and ACT scores to colleges through the testing website.
 - SAT website- <http://www.collegeboard.org/>
 - ACT website- <http://www.actstudent.org/>

Completing Applications:

- ✓ Complete college applications on College website and/or on Common Application website.
- ✓ During bonus block, college application help sessions will be available in the fall. Stop in the College Counseling office for dates and location.
